There is less gas in the 2018 Katalin Iturzaeta, and the palate also feels a bit more mellow and shy, without the youth of the 2019 or the nuance of the 2017. It has some aromas and flavors of freshwater and white flowers, delicate and shy. It's soft and feels quite polished. Drink up. 4,000 bottles were filled in May 2019.

Jokin Aranzábal is the great-grandson of Katalin Iturzaeta, and he produces a single cuvée of a very traditional Txakoli from Getaria from 0.6 hectares of vines, most of them centenary, with some dissolved gas and is presented in a classical Rhin bottle. Production varies between 2,500 and 4,000 bottles, depending on the vintage. He doesn't export to the US, but his wine can be found in Toronto, Canada.
